## ACHIEVING ACADEMIC SUCCESS

### BEST CHOICE CENTER:

is an academic after school and summer camp program for children in grades K-12 who live in poverty

- 100% of students advanced a grade level
- 92% of all students maintained a C or above in reading
- Honor roll incentive - 70% achieved



### WORK & EARN IT AND TEEN COURT

programs give more than 200 students annually a way to provide monetary or voluntary restitution for juvenile offenses

## BUILDING SUCCESSFUL LIVES

### THE HAWLEY HOUSE:

is the only state-licensed residential program in Forsyth County for women suffering from Substance Use Disorder

- Comprehensive program with healthcare referral, counseling, life skills training, connection to employment/educational opportunities, and transportation
- Strong results: 75-80% success upon graduation
- Expanded capacity by 50% in 2020

### PROJECT NEW START:

a prison ministry provides weekly outreach for 720 women annually who are incarcerated at the Forsyth County Detention Center

## DEVELOPING HEALTHY LIFESTYLES

### GATEWAY TO SUCCESS:

is a strategic alliance with Atrium Health Wake Forest Baptist & Novant Health for diabetes prevention and management

- Provides access for low income patients to a fitness facility, dietitian, behavioral health specialist and wellness coach at the Gateway
- Our unique integrated care model achieved exceptional results: 87% maintained or decreased BMI, 65% maintained or decreased A1C, 78% improved health wellness
- Reduced depression scores and suicidal thoughts
- Presented and published at the National Meeting for the Society of Internal Medicine, May 2019



### MILESTONE:

Recently the YWCA brought resolution to our debt and reduced future capital needs by 82%. We are thankful to the United Way and our collaborative partners for the evidence-based work and strong outcomes we have achieved in our community.

We now have momentum and can focus all of our attention on our life-changing programs.
